

CHOIR OUTFIT INFORMATION

2011-2012 School Year

ALL WOMEN (all Girls)

We have decided to continue to use the current Choir Dress as the company still has it in stock and we couldn't find anything better for the price! If you still have your dress from last year (and it still fits!) **KEEP IT AND USE IT AGAIN THIS YEAR** (and save \$65)! If you are new to the program this year, dress fittings will be taking place during class the first several days of school so that the dresses can be ordered in time for Dress Rehearsal and the October performances. For those ordering a new dress, **MONEY NEEDS TO BE EARNED IN YOUR STUDENT ACCOUNT (and/or paid for by check or cash) no later than Thursday, September 29th**. The cost for the dress and the pearl necklace is \$65.00. Replacement necklaces cost \$10.00 each.

Each student is responsible for her own **BLACK, CLOSED-TOE DRESS SHOES AND BLACK NYLON STOCKINGS** for performances. Outfits will be worn for the first time on October 17th (Treble Dress Rehearsal) or October 18th (the Concert Choirs).

The Blue and Gold Napa High Choir Shirt will be given to every new choir student – this shirt will be used every year for casual performances (the first time will be at “Singing In The Spotlight” and on Choir Tours). Students may trade up for a different size if the original shirt is returned in EXCELLENT, CLEAN condition. Otherwise, students should hold on to this shirt each year as it costs \$20.00 to replace. When we wear the Choir Shirt, each student is responsible for their own **blue jeans, tennis shoes and socks**.

MEN'S CHOIR (First Period Boys)

For more formal performances (Home concerts and Dress Rehearsals), students will be responsible to get their own white button down dress shirt, black “Dockers” type pants and necktie that has any combination of blue and/or gold, black dress shoes and socks.

The Blue and Gold Napa High Choir Shirt will be given to every new choir student – this shirt will be used every year for casual performances (the first time will be at “Singing In The Spotlight” and on Choir Tours). Students may trade up for a different size if the original shirt is returned in EXCELLENT, CLEAN condition. Otherwise, students should hold on to this shirt each year as it costs \$20.00 to replace. When we wear the Choir Shirt, each student is responsible for their own **blue jeans, tennis shoes and socks**.

CONCERT CHOIR MEN (Third, Fourth and Fifth Period Boys)

The Choral Boosters Club is again renting the Choir Tuxes (pants, jacket, cummerbund and tie). Men will deposit the amount of \$50.00 to secure the tuxedo for the school year. \$20.00 of this deposit will be returned to the student's account (or directly to the student if a graduating senior) at the end of the school year when the tux pieces are returned in good and reusable condition. Should additional ties and/or cummerbunds need to be purchased during the course of the year, the student will be charged \$5.00/tie and \$10.00/cummerbund for replacements to complete the tux unit. Students will be measured for tuxes during classtime during the first few days of school. Tuxes are expected to arrive in late September.

We are using the same tux shirt as last year. Men new to the choral department this year and those who may need a new tux shirt will be measured in class and shirts will be ordered to be ready in time for the Fall and Mont La Salle concerts in October. The shirt costs \$20.00 and is kept by the student (the same shirts is used every year). The shirt should be paid for by cash or check **no later than Thursday, September 29th**.

Each student is responsible for his own black dress shoes and black dress socks for concert performances. Outfits will be worn for the first time at the October 19th and 20th Fall Concerts.
